



























PROJECT AIM

■ By June 2020 (!) the amount of IBD Nurse time taken to co-ordinate the biologic patient journey to the point of booking first infusion will reduce by 20%.




Primary drivers:

- Optimise the use of patient time

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
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



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Create a Biologic Nurse-led clinic







- ► 50% reduction in IBD nurse contact points to 1st infusion
- ► 51% reduction in IBD nurse time taken to 1st infusion
- Clear process for biologic new starts
- One stop shop for patients yay!

- Great support network (out-with working environment)


Even better if...
